Dear students, here **are** some brief information about programs that can be offered by Exchange Programs Office:

ERASMUS+ (26 Countries with 162 partner universities in Europe):

- 1- One- Term/Semester study experience at one of our partner universities
 - 2- Traineeship (Placement) experience at a company in a EU country.
- *Traineeship/Placement programs can be voluntarily (minimum of 60 days).

WORLS EXCHANGE (50 partner universities in South Korea, Japan, Canada, China, Hong Kong etc.):

One-term study experience at a partner university in and outside of Europe.

*All of our agreements in **U.S.A** have been **suspended** temporarily.

*On the other hand, you will have options in Hong Kong, South Korea, and at our USAC partners which has various options from China to Australia to Latin America and Europe.

What is the difference between Erasmus + and World Exchange Programs?

- The difference between above programs is that you will receive a monthly grant (financial support) provided by the Turkish National Agency in Erasmus+ Programs. You will not receive any grant as a beneficiary in World Exchange Programs however you will be exempt from the tuition fee at the partner university.
- Erasmus + is currently exchanges with only European Union countries.
- World Exchange includes countries from China to South Korea to European and South American institutions.

The updated Lists of Partner Universities with available quotas for both of the programs are being announced at our website prior to each application period.

As BAU Exchange Programs Office, we are responsible for a fair and transparent selection of our applicants. Secondly, we are responsible of nominating you to the partner university. The nominees are on their own and have the %100 responsibility of their applications to the partner universities, accommodation and visa applications.

Basically, you will be responsible of below steps and procedures before, during and after your exchange:

- 1- Requirements before and after the application here at BAU.
- 2- Application to the host University
- 3- Application to VISA at the relevant country consulate.
- 4- Requirements after finishing your abroad studies.

***DO NOT FORGET** that even if, your name is among the winners; your status will be still 'nominee' until you apply to and get letter of acceptance from the selected host university.
