



## Information for our Exchange Partners

As we expect ERASMUS+ students from all over Europe, we would like to inform you about our university's precautions and measures regarding the COVID-19 pandemic. Below you can find answers to some of the most frequently asked questions and concerns.

# Situation for New Incoming ERASMUS+ Students

### **Current situation**

- As of now, we still expect our exchange to go ahead as planned. Please be advised, however, that teaching activities, including preparatory language classes, are suspended and libraries are closed until April 19<sup>th</sup> 2020. The University of Freiburg bases its measures on the recommendations of the <u>Robert-Koch-</u><u>Institute</u>.
- Our welcome event for new ERASMUS+ students has been cancelled.
- The city of Freiburg has issued a decree prohibiting gatherings of more than 50 people. People are advised to stay home and limit contact to others as much as possible.
- So far, there has been one confirmed case at the university.

#### Preparations before arrival

- Students should take note of entry and exit regulations for <u>Germany</u> and their home countries.
- For questions concerning courses and alternative teaching activities, students should contact their departmental coordinators. A list with the contact information of all coordinators is attached.
- Matriculation for international students has been digitalised. Your students will shortly receive detailed instructions on how to enrol at our university. Please also note that our office is closed for the public, although we are still available via email and phone.
- Students who wish to cancel their mobility must do so by March 23<sup>rd</sup> 2020, via email to <u>europa@zv.uni-freiburg.de</u>.
- Students from high-risk areas or students who travel through high-risk areas should take precautions and self-isolate for two weeks upon arrival in Freiburg.

- We will provide all incoming exchange students with relevant information regarding university actions. To keep students up to date, we recommend that they:
  - o check their e-mails regularly
  - o visit the <u>university website</u>
  - check their national health ministry as well as the German <u>Robert-Koch-</u> <u>Institute</u> frequently for recommendations and updates.
