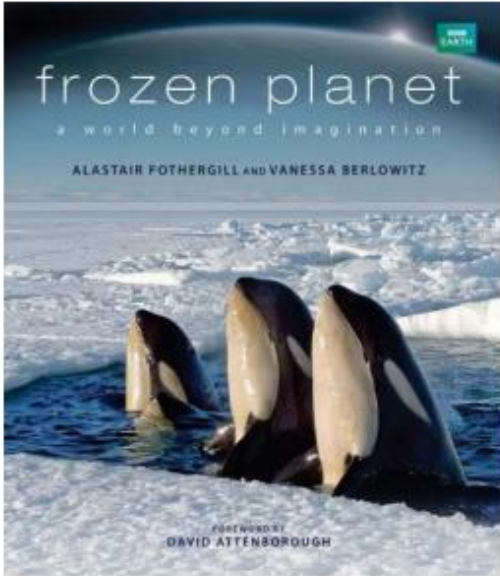
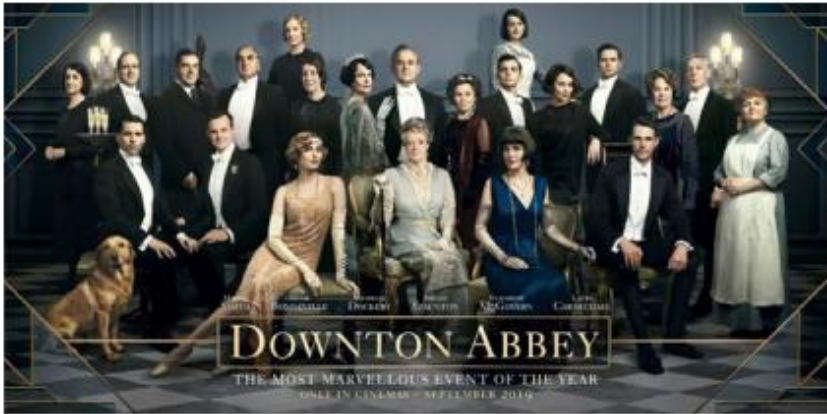

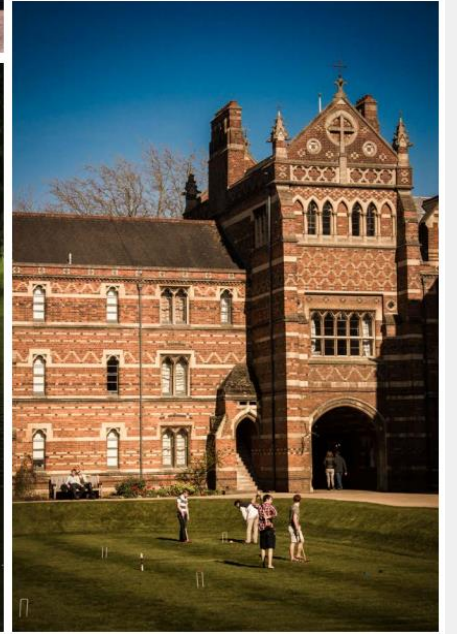

Programme Fee

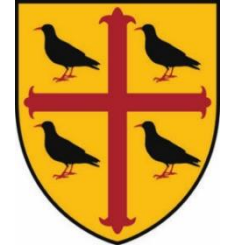

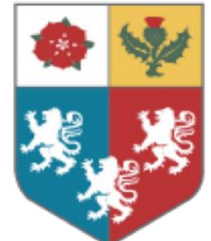

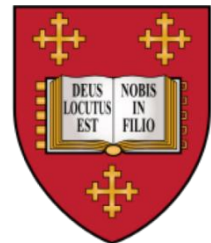

How does it work?



- 3rd or 4th year
- 8-week terms (trimesters)
- 'Major' and 'minor' tutorial each term
- 8hrs + 4hrs
- Grade given at the end of each term



Application Materials

1. A personal statement (up to 500 words)
2. Two samples of recently completed written work in one of the subjects for which you are applying
3. A transcript (in English translation)
4. A recent photograph
5. Two academic recommendations
6. Photocopy of IELTS or TOEFL certificate
7. Application form
8. Photocopy of passport

Basic + Key Requirements

1. GPA: above 3.7 (4.0 GPA system)
2. English Qualification

IELTS overall score of 7.5 (minimum 7.0 per component).

TOEFL the required score is minimum 110, with component scores of at least: Listening 22, Reading 24, Speaking 25, and Writing 24.

Fees (refer to VSP Brochure)

- **Tuition Fee: 35,260 - 59,260 GBP**
subject dependent
- **Living costs: 11,000 - 20,000 GBP**

Timeline:

- **12th January:** Application deadline.
- **End of March to end of April:** Expect to hear back regarding the status of your application and receive offers.
- **April – July:** confirm your place, complete required procedures and receive CAS information to apply for your visa.
- **September-October:** Arrive in Oxford as a Registered Visiting Student at University of Oxford.
